



## RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT PROGRAM INFORMATION PACKAGE

### PROHIBITED ITEMS

For reasons related to program, resident safety and community well-being, we do not allow certain items to be brought into the STC Residential Treatment Program. However, many items (gum, candy, drinks, cigarettes, etc.) are available for purchase from our In-Store (weekly purchases) and Out-Store (one-time purchases). To ensure consistency of items brought into our program, the following is a list of items you CANNOT bring into treatment.

#### Prohibited Items List

- Any food, candy, chips, gum
- Drugs that are not prescribed by a physician (unopened vitamins are permitted)
- Alcoholic-flavored food or beverages
- Any items containing alcohol
- Weapons of any kind
- Electronic devices such as MP3 players, TV's, DVD players, e-Readers, etc.
- Cell phones
- Pornographic materials
- Books, magazines, posters and clothing that are inappropriate for a treatment program (this includes Maxim & Cosmo magazines)
- Bodybuilding supplements such as creatine, amino acids, steroids, protein pills, powders & drinks
- Cameras
- Alarm clocks
- Cologne and perfume (Stonehenge is a scent-reduced facility)
- Clothing, posters or reading material that promotes or advertises alcohol or drug use
- Personal pillows, bedding or blankets
- Musical instruments or items of significant value such as guitars, golf clubs, etc.
- Expensive jewelry or sentimental items of value
- Vehicles – no vehicles may be left on site during treatment stays

#### Please Note:

Bags will be checked when you enter the program. If any of the above items are found they will be sent back with the support person who brought you to Stonehenge.
